



## **2012 Scholarship Awards**

Scholarships are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. We will strive to distribute scholarships throughout the year so all classes will have scholarship opportunities.

Scholarship funds managed by the School of Phlebotomy may come from a variety of sources and vary from year to year. Scholarships are intended to attract high caliber students into healthcare who might not be able to afford the education without some financial assistance. Successful applicants must show superior academic / work performance and participation in community service.

### **The Kim Baker Memorial Scholarship - \$2,500 (full tuition) available only once yearly**

The Kim Baker Memorial Scholarship is in memory of our much loved and missed instructor who passed away suddenly on February 7, 2010. We award this scholarship to a worthy student in the March evening track class every year. March was the month of Kim's birthday. The scholarship is for \$2,500; the entire cost of the class. Successful scholarship candidates are asked to write a letter of acknowledgement and appreciation to her family. To be considered for this scholarship, please write an essay of up to 250 words, as to why you are the person who should receive this scholarship and how you plan to use this education. Interviews will be conducted after narrowing down the essays to three and we will select one person after the interview process. Please use the scholarship application form attached. Application deadline for this scholarship is March 6, 2012 and is only available for the March evening class.

### **Greiner Bio-One U.S.A. Scholarship - \$1,000 several available yearly**

#### **Scholarship Eligibility:**

1. Be a US citizen or permanent legal resident.
2. Applicant must meet minimum requirements for the program and be accepted for enrollment to attend the School of Phlebotomy, Corydon Indiana.
3. Applicant must have a career direction related to the field of Healthcare.
4. Applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 (on a 4.0 scale) or higher or have an outstanding work history.
5. Successful scholarship candidates must also have documented proof of community service.
